

University Requirements

Great exam grades are not enough to gain entry to top UK universities. These universities often have extra requirements that count for more than your A-Level grades and require lots of further preparation, including personal statements, admissions tests, written submissions and interviews.

Through the different stages of the application process, top UK universities are looking to screen for the following qualities:

- Academic Ability
- Critical Thinking/ Problem-Solving Skills
- Wider Reading
- Passion for Your Subject

Oxford and Cambridge

Imperial College



With an application success rate of 14%, Imperial College London is one of the most prestigious and competitive universities to apply to in the UK for STEM subjects. If you apply to Imperial you will be assessed on your grades and the quality of your personal statement. Departments such as Mathematics and Medicine also use external admissions tests to assess candidates.

Medicine



Applicants for Medicine can apply to up to four medical courses by the early deadline of 15 October. Personal statements are written in a very different way to other subjects, with a focus on work experience, medical ethics, healthcare systems and research developments. Medicine applicants are advised to apply for some universities that require the UKAT admissions test and some that require the BMAT. Most universities assess applicants through academic interviews.
